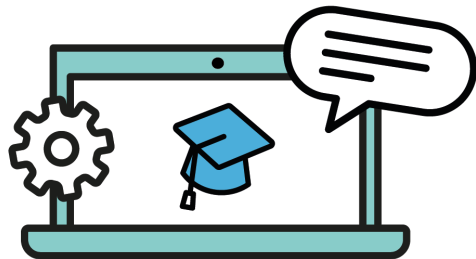

Digital Communities Wales- The Current Digital Inclusion Picture

- 7% of the population of Wales not online.
- 22% of Internet users lack essential digital skills, this increases to 59% for people over 75.
- Older people, people with disabilities and limiting long term illness are less likely to be online.

Digital Communities Wales is a national programme with a cascade approach to consistent delivery of support across Wales



Revised DCW delivery plan from April 1st 2024

April 1st 2024 – 30th June 2025: Programme Aim

Embed and mainstream digital inclusion within identified thematic areas ensuring ownership of digital inclusion by existing stakeholders and organisations.

Crosscutting activities

- Encouraging organisations and people to engage, promote and raise awareness for 'Help Someone you know to get online' map.
- Continued promotion of the National Digital Inclusion Network including data and device bank (GTF).
- Device loans for projects with greatest impact relating to the thematic groups

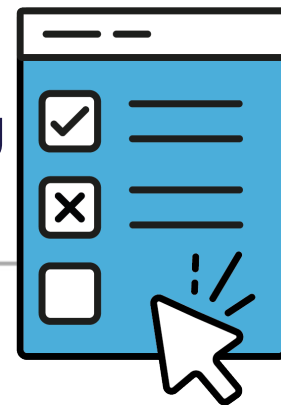

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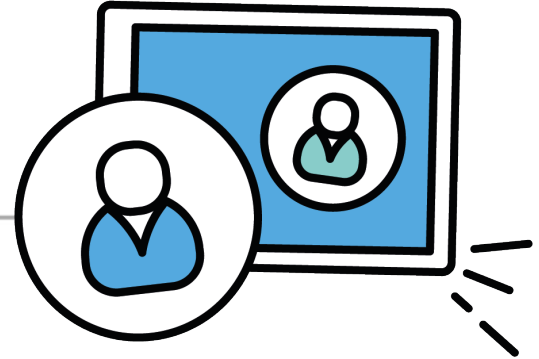
Non-thematic areas of focus

Digital Inclusion Alliance Wales (DIAW)

- By September 2024, identify a collectively owned plan for an appropriate structure and funding model to allow DIAW to be self-sustaining and independent, with clear ownership of the Alliance by the Steering Group.

Communities for Work + (CfW+)

- Continue to work with CfW+ on CfW+ and ReACT loan schemes until March 2025.

On-hand advice and support whenever it's needed.



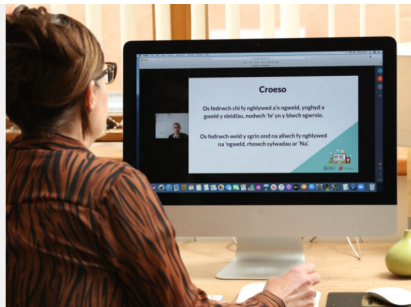

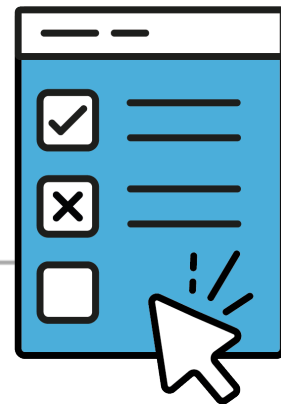
