

Tactical Diversion Routes

PHYSICAL IMPLEMENTATION

Location

Action

- Erect 'ROAD AHEAD CLOSED' sign indicating alternative route symbol to follow on Northbound A487 sliproad off of Ridgeway roundabout. Erect 'END OF DIVERSION' sign on A478 approach to roundabout.
- Erect direction signs from A478 onto B4332 and B4332 onto A478 at junction.
- Erect direction signs from B4332 onto A484 and from A484 onto B4332 at junction.
- 4. Erect direction signs from A484 onto A475 and from A475 onto A484
- 5. Erect direction signs from A475 onto B4333 and from B4333 onto A475
- 6. Erect confirmation signs at junction with
- 7. Erect 'ROAD AHEAD CLOSED' sign indicating alternative route symbol to follow, on Southbound A487 at Tan-y-groes junction. Erect 'END OF DIVERSION' signs on B4333 approach to junction
- Erect 'ROAD AHEAD CLOSED' sign on approach to Hospital Roundabout indicating local traffic to join A478 at Ridgeway Roundabout
- Hospital located at Cardigan
- Livestock markets located at Cardigan & Newcastle Emlyn

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Ceredigion County Council control points at Ridgeway Roundabout and at Tan-y-groes.



NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Divert at Ridgeway roundabout onto A478, joining the B4332, at Cenarth join A484 to Newcastle Emlyn, then A475 at Adpar onto B4333 through Cwm-cou and rejoin A487 at Tan-y-groes.

SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC

Divert onto B4333 at Tan-y-groes, continue through Cwm-cou to Adpar then the A475 to Newcastle Emlyn, take the A484 at Cenarth take the B4332 then join the A478, rejoin the A487 at Cardigan Ridgeway roundabout.
