Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol

- (1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence—
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- (2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory condition where the premises licence includes a Condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity:

- (1) Each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- (2) But nothing in (1) above requires such a condition to be imposed—
 - (a) in respect of premises within paragraph 8(3)(a) of Schedule 2 to the Private Security Industry Act 2001 (c. 12) (premises with premises licences authorising plays or films), or
 - (b) in respect of premises in relation to—
 - (i) any occasion mentioned in paragraph 8(3)(b) or (c) of that Schedule (premises being used exclusively by club with club premises certificate, under a temporary event notice authorising plays or films or under a gaming licence), or
 - (ii) any occasion within paragraph 8(3)(d) of that Schedule (occasions prescribed by regulations under that Act).
- (3) For the purposes of this section—
 - (a) “security activity” means an activity to which paragraph 2(1)(a) of that Schedule applies, and
 - (b) paragraph 8(5) of that Schedule (interpretation of references to an occasion) applies as it applies in relation to paragraph 8 of that Schedule.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

- a. General – all four licensing objectives:- We intend to carry out our usual organized activities, as listed below.
- b. Prevention of Crime and Disorder:- The committee together with voluntary stewards and hired security staff, patrol the premises, both in and out, together with the aid of radios and telescopic light towers in strategic points. Checks are made on entry and any brought in alcohol disposed of. No alcohol is to be served to anyone under 18 years old and if in doubt ID is requested. Anyone behaving in a drunken, quarrelsome or threatening manner will be ejected from the premises and if necessary the Police will be informed.
- c. Public Safety:- As above b, and hire of fire extinguishers and specialist electrical extinguishers. A qualified electrician and first aiders on premises at all times. All electrical equipment are fenced off. Fire exits are kept clear at all times. Public liability insurance cover will be in place. Emergency lights with battery back up are used. Two generators are used in case of one failing.
- d. Prevention of Public Nuisance:- Committee, Stewards and hired Security patrol the premises at all times, wearing fluorescent coats, and have proved to be a good deterrent to any incidents occurring. Any wrong doers are ejected from the premises. The nearest house is approximately 200 yards away and no noise complaints have been received over the years.
- e. Protection of Children from Harm:- We do not encourage any children under the age of 16 to attend only if accompanied by an adult and anyone under 18 are not served by the bar staff.
