What is the Mid Wales Regional Transport Plan?

The aim of the Mid Wales Regional Transport Plan is to help solve the current and future transport problems in the region over the next five years. It will guide decisions on future transport investment, ensuring that Mid Wales can support national, regional and local ambitions for the transport network.



What are the key issues in Mid Wales?

Limited access to employment and services for those without access to a car.



Lack of alterative travel options such as walking and cycling.



Limited opportunities to pass and overtake on the highway causing delay and congestion.



Limited and infrequent public transport options.



Climate change such as flooding makes the transport network less reliable.



Ageing population which will present challenges in future transport provision.




High dependency on car for travel.



Poor condition of the road has an impact on safety.
